Goals for the Week

I hope everyone had a fantastic Spring Break! We are moving on to the letter Tt, for timothy tiger. This is also the time of the year that we start talking about and exploring the hard working vowel letters as well.

Phonemic Awareness: listening for the Tt sound in words, rhyming words with –ap at the end, and exploring more nursery rhymes.

Alphabetic Principle: Tt words, spelling Tt words, matching lower case to upper case, explore the –ap word family, and the three day a week students will start letter ladders with the letter t (ta, te, ti, to, tu). In addition, recognizes words that are in the sentence structure pattern in the book, “It Is Spring”

Comprehension: Recalling the order from The Napping House, as well as retelling what signs of spring we can see from the book “It Is Spring”

Book of the week: “The Napping House”

Reader of the Week: “It Is Spring”

Math goals: making a train that counts by 10’s to 100, writing numbers 0, 1, and 2 (we did not get to this before break), adding with colored cubes, matching colors to color words
